

BOD HOA Informational Meeting
Thursday, February 14, 2019, 7:00 PM
Addendum to BOD HOA Board Meeting, February 4, 2019

- All Board members were present. Secretary Peg Smith announced that the **minutes** from the February 4, 2019 were **posted** on the HOA website. She also reread the **correspondence** from the February 4th Board Meeting and one new letter in the Suggestion Box from James Schisler supporting the Crane Lakes Performers
- President Diane Grzelak introduced **Speaker**, Chief Grimaldi, Port Orange Police Department. The Chief highlighted two issues: 1) Always lock your vehicle doors, even at home, due to increase in thefts and 2) Do not give money to panhandlers as that just encourages them, rather donate the money to charities that help the legitimate homeless.
- New items under **Committee Reports** are as follows: 1) Tickets are available for the Daytona Playhouse Murder Mystery on February 16th, 2) There are 7 tables remaining for the Trash and Treasure event, 3) Bill Hawkins, FMO Representative, stated that the FMO meeting hosted by Crane Lakes was not well organized by the FMO in a way to be helpful to those new in attendance and that he would follow up with the FMO officials and Barb Hawkins thanked Crane Lakes residents for their generous donations for the food drive.
- President Grzelak reviewed some information from the February 4th Board meeting under **New Business**. She explained the items covered in the Management Meeting with the HOA and expressed that it was a good meeting and that there were ongoing positive relations with management. Management signed the Key Fobs contract and Key Fobs should be available soon. Regarding the Spectrum conversion, a majority of residents have expressed they are happy.
- There were several **Member Comments**: announcement of Blood Drive April 1 at 10:00 AM, trees cut down must be replaced and can be replaced at most locations, a Crane Lakes resident incidence of road rage after being asked to slow down was shared, and concern was expressed that the mailboxes need painting, but only the post office, under federal law, can undertake the painting.
- **Board Member Comments**: Chief Grimaldi was excellent as a speaker, the speaker for March 14th Informational Meeting is Rose Taub on the topic of guiding through the stages of aging, Jean Hoon received a special thank you and appreciation for serving as an excellent HOA Secretary and thanks was expressed to the residents for their attendance at the meeting.
- **President Grzelak Comments** stated that the Crane Lakes community was an outstanding place to live due to the involvement and cooperation of the residents and that the HOA Board and committee chairs work hard in the best interest of all.
